

Golfers Win 5th Crown

After a season has ended, some coaches don't like to think of the future. But in the case of coach Al Greenleaf's golf team, it is just the opposite. Last week the Warriors wrapped up their fifth conference championship by knocking off Santa Monica and it was accomplished with four freshmen and two sophomores.

"I have to hand it to this year's team," said coach Al Greenleaf. "They were constantly pulling for each other and this is unusual for such a young team. They're a great bunch of kids who faced up to all the pressure very well," said the coach.

"What helped our team was the fact we have a different member coming through for us each match. We had no top man because every golfer is equal and this balance was our main factor," coach Greenleaf elaborated proudly.

The four freshmen who did an outstanding job for the golf team this season are Bob Hamilton, Jim Weir, Romeo Chacon and Don Lucarelli. The two sophomores are Bob Schwarz and Jim Stephenson.

Hamilton was the most consistent of the golfers while carrying a five handicap and averaging 75. At Morningside, Hamilton competed in golf for four years and was named to the CIF first team selections in 1967.

Weir, low medalist for five matches, averaged 77. The Torrance grad didn't compete in athletics in high school, but he had plenty of time to polish up on his golf game.

Chacon, an ex-Marine, got in the groove in the middle of the season and has been "tearing up" the course ever since. Chacon won first place honors in the Rio Hondo Tournament.

Nicknamed "Luke" by his teammates, Don Lucarelli is another late starter. As the season progressed so did the "Luke." Before the season, Don captured low net honors in the college intramural tournament.

Handicap To Be Run Saturday

One of the fleetest fields of older fillies and mares to meet anywhere in the country this year is on hand for the second running of the \$30,000 added Hollypark Ladies Handicap at Hollywood Park Saturday.

Owner William Haggin Perry of Virginia, whose barn seems to be filled with championship calibre fillies and who has won eight stakes with them during the past two Hollywood Park seasons, has three eligible for the Hollypark Ladies. Two of them already have been winners at the meeting.

Gamely, whose 1968 races stamp her as a solid contender for national "Filly of the Year" honors, was most impressive in winning the \$23,150 Wilshire Handicap last week.

Due to make her seasonal debut in the Hollypark Ladies is Princessnesian, whose smashing, eight-length victory in the second division of the Santa Barbara Handicap on the grass at Santa Anita earned her that meet's older filly and mare championship.

Desert Law, the third Perry candidate, had little difficulty scoring at a mile and one-sixteenth on the grass in her first local outing and also was a turf course stakes winner at Santa Anita.

Ready to battle the Perry forces will be Patrick Madden's world record holder Pink Pigeon, the fast-flying daughter of T. V. Lark, who has won a pair of races this season, including the \$23,000 Coronado Stakes.

At Santa Anita Pink Pigeon lowered the world mark for a mile and one-eighth on the grass to 1:45 4/5.

Still another strong Hollypark Ladies threat will be Desi Arnez Amerigo's Fancy, the grass-loving daughter of Amerigo, who upset Gamely in the first division of the Santa Barbara. Amerigo's Fancy was third in a division of the Hollypark Ladies last year.

Forgiving, Gypsy Queen III, Shore, and Spinning Around also are expected to be in the starting lineup Saturday.

Big Brothers Grid Tickets Go on Sale

Thirty thousand tickets to the second annual Big Brothers All-Star Football Game July 11 at the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum have gone out to varsity football coaches at 83 high schools in Los Angeles, Orange, Ventura and Santa Barbara Counties for a four-week advance sale.

Ticket sales director Ed Salter revealed that nearly 18,000 tickets are being distributed to the 47 Los Angeles city varsity head football coaches. Each coach is receiving a minimum allocation of 250 tickets, Salter indicated, and some have asked for as many as 500.

The remaining 12,000 tickets are divided among head varsity football coaches at 39 parochial high schools in the four counties.

Student tickets, priced at \$1 each, and general admission tickets, priced at \$2, are available through the coaches until June 7, after which the student ticket will no longer be offered.

Tickets distribution to the Catholic school coaches is being handled on a geographical basis by seven coaches—Phil Cantwell, Bishop Amat (La Puente), southeast area; George Swade, Bishop Montgomery (Torrance), Bob Baiz Lasuen (San Pedro), southwest; Jim Yang, St. Francis (La Canada), northeast; Lou Crijanovich, Santa Clara (Oxnard), northwest; and Bob Hollycross, Salesian, central.
